ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into between Northland Community and Technical College (hereinafter sending institution), and **University of Mary** (hereinafter receiving institution). This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the North Dakota.

The sending institution has established degrees in the following program (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established the following program(s) (hereinafter receiving program(s)), and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another:

It is mutually agreed:

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- a) The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- b) Students must fulfill the graduation requirements at both institutions.
- c) Students must complete the entire sending program and meet the receiving institution's admission requirements for the agreement to apply.
- d) Each institution shall determine the modality for delivering its courses, whether seated, online, or blended.

Transfer of Credits

The receiving institution will accept a maximum of **62** credits from the sending program. Remaining credits, as specified in the appended degree plan tables, will be completed at the receiving institution. Courses will transfer as described in the appended degree plan tables.

Implementation and Review

The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the Terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with their policies, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to programs occur while the agreement is in effect.

When a student notifies the receiving institution of their intent to follow this agreement, the receiving institution will encode course waivers and substitutions.

Effective Date and Duration

This Articulation Agreement is effective on $\frac{09/30/2020}{}$ (insert date) and shall remain in effect until terminated or amended by either party with 30 days prior written notice.
