The sending institution has established a training/certification program in the following area (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established a graduate certificate in the following (hereinafter receiving program), and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another:

It is mutually agreed:

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- a) The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- b) Students must complete the entire sending program and meet the receiving institution's admission requirements for the agreement to apply.
- c) Each institution shall determine the modality for delivering its courses, whether seated, online, or blended.

Transfer of Credits

The receiving institution will accept completion of the Emmaus Institute certificate program as prior learning toward the nine credits required of the Sacred Scripture certificate, which is a component of the M.A. in Applied Catholic Theology. Remaining master's program credits will be completed at the receiving institution. Students must provide an official record of Emmaus Institute certificate completion in order to receive this credit. Students must enroll at the University of Mary in an applicable degree program order to receive these prior learning credits—no graduate credit can be transcribed for non-matriculated students.

Implementation and Review

The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the Terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

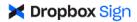
The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to programs occur while the agreement is in effect.
